English Class Ministry for Children!

Following a nearly two year “ban” of our English class by the neighborhood administrators and certain neighbors, our English class is once again in full swing! The Lord has answered our prayers and provided a place to meet, support from the apartment complex board of directors and plenty of children! With nearly 20 kids registered we are now into the third week of class which meets every Saturday from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. This wonderful ministry has enabled us to reconnect with both children and parents in ways that provide opportunities for us to share the Gospel.

Training Pastors at the Seminary

Nathan has begun to teach classes once again at the SEUT seminary where much has changed. One dear colleague has gone to be with the Lord and half of our staff members have moved on to different ministries. All of these changes have come at a time when the seminary needs to rise to new challenges. One of the most pressing needs is to meet the Spanish Government requirements for accreditation. This summer, we are thankful to report that Spain will finally accredit evangelical theological schools! Though being accredited implies a different sort of work we are confident that this recent move will draw more students as well as motivate the seminary to uphold the highest of standards for those who come for pastoral training. Some students preparing for ministry you could pray for are *Mariano, Jonathan, Marta, Cristina and Salvador*.

Local Church Work

We are thankful for the opportunities to help in Sunday School and the youth group in Madrid. Pray that the children will have a clear understanding of the Gospel and that the Lord will continue to use us in various new Bible study groups and preaching opportunities in the greater Madrid area. Please pray also for a new Spanish church plant that is meeting once a month in

our children's school. We are hopeful that some of our neighbors and families in the area might attend in the near future. Pray for *Jacobo*, a student at our SEUT seminary, who is leading this new initiative.

Another school year has begun for our family! Katerina Ruth is now in Fourth Grade. She continues to enjoy the violin and participating in the school's choir. Nathan Kiriakos is in Second Grade, plays the piano and has joined the Basketball team. Melina Faith has begun school for the very first time! The first week was one full of tears and mixed feelings but now she likes going to school now and playing with her new friends. Please pray for their progress, protection and for the ability to adapt to their very long school days which go from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. We are thankful that every year they make more friends and far exceed their father in "proper" Castilian Spanish.
